Free standing model which is supported by "L" brackets mounted to the wall. Patents pending on these designs.

The rear corner drain pushes the plumbing to the rear corner allowing for full wheelchair access. The front deck for a faucet allows for easy access to the faucet.

Barrier free does not have to be unattractive any more!



Just open the doors, the entire area under the sink is open to slide a wheel chair underneath with total access. The sink is lowered for optimal use, and still workable for those who might stand at the sink.
